The day was made even more special as we celebrated a wedding anniversary for Moira and her husband Joseph. It was lovely to mark such an important milestone and share in their happiness.

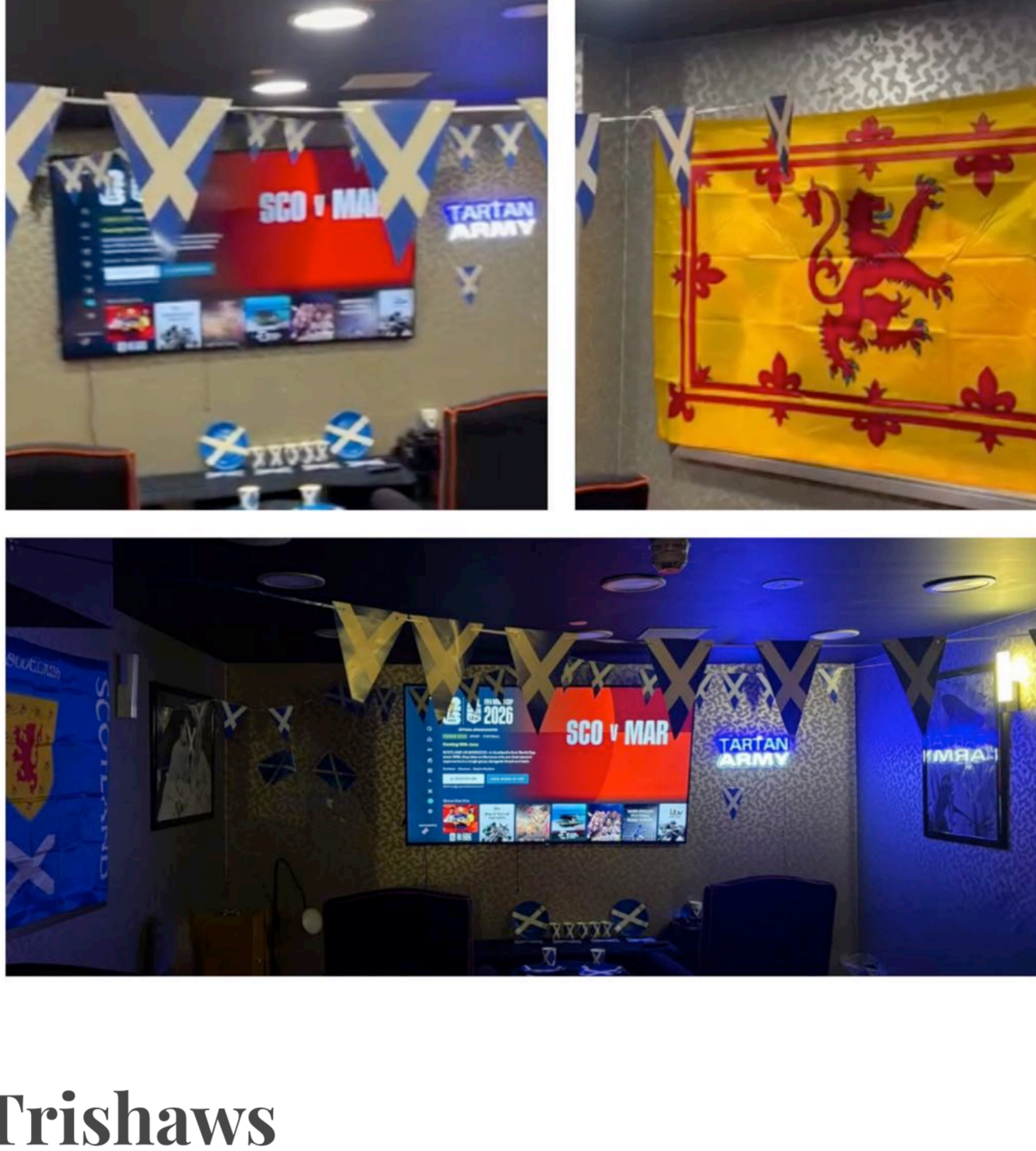


FIFA World Cup 2026

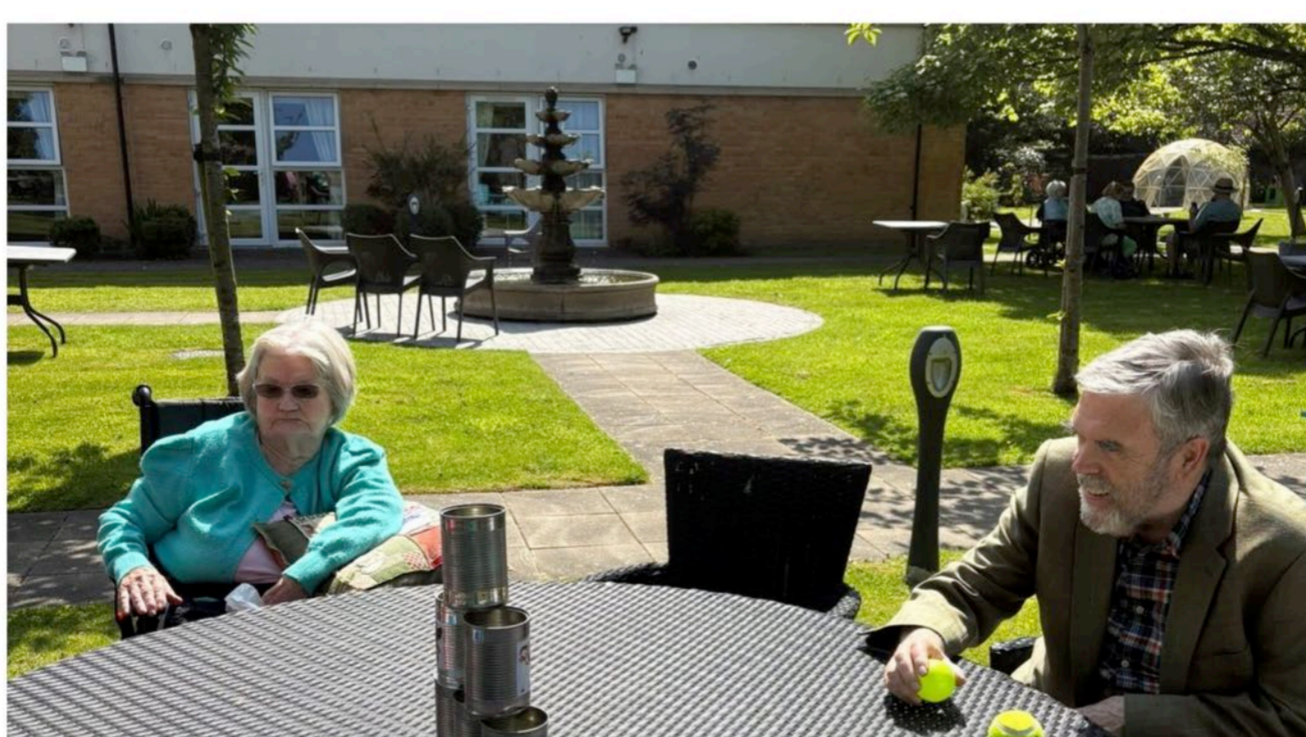
Fun fact: Did you know Empire Biscuits originated in Scotland? A classic sweet biscuit known for their jam filling and icing topping.

It was a lovely day that highlighted how meaningful simple shared experiences can be.



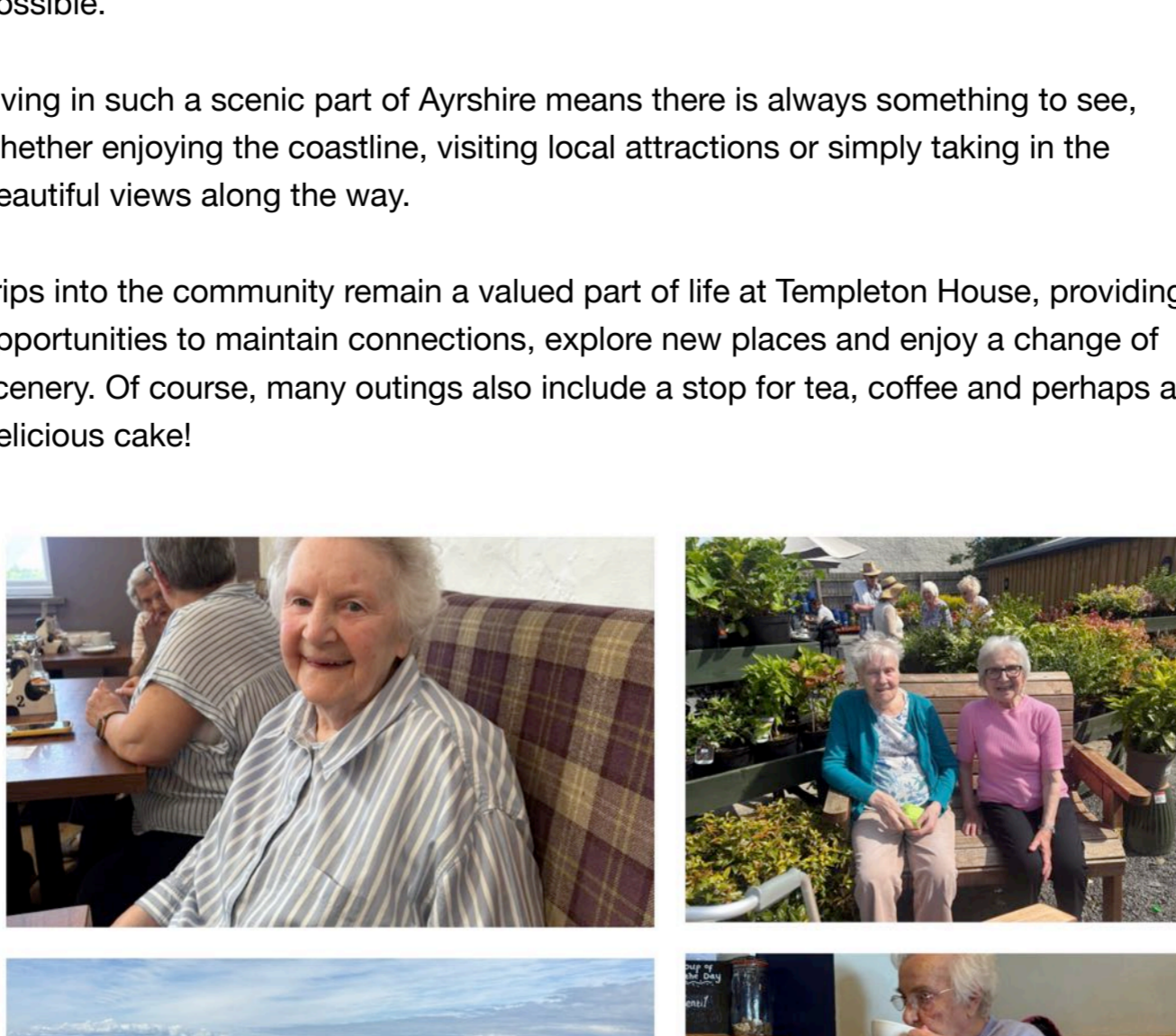
OUT & ABOUT

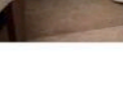
