Thank you again for all the generous donations and support we received. It was very much a community event, and we are delighted with the amount raised.

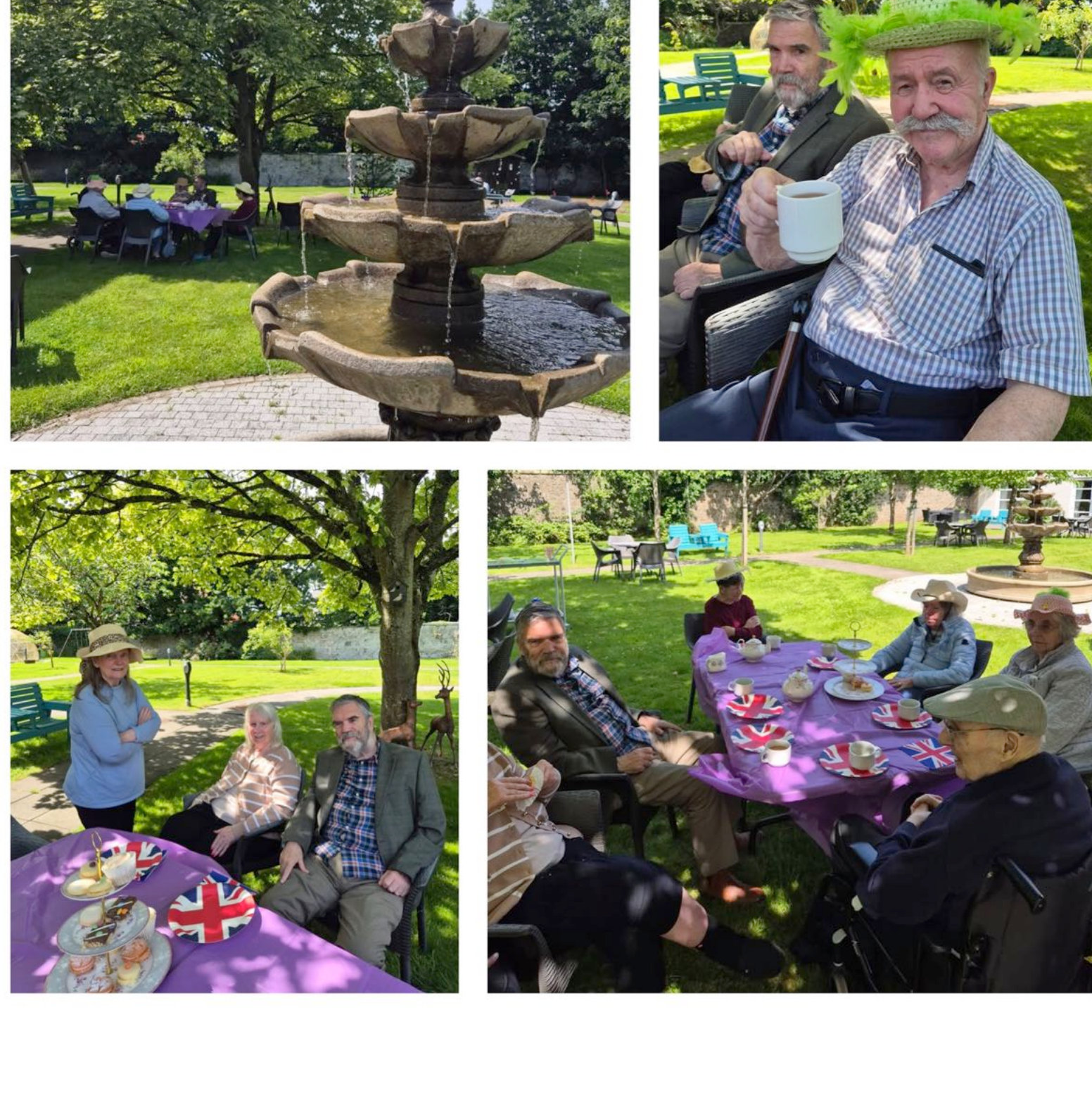
Our next date for the diary is 19th December, when we will be holding our Winter Fete.

A visit to The Field of Heroes provided an opportunity for residents to spend time sharing their war stories and memories.

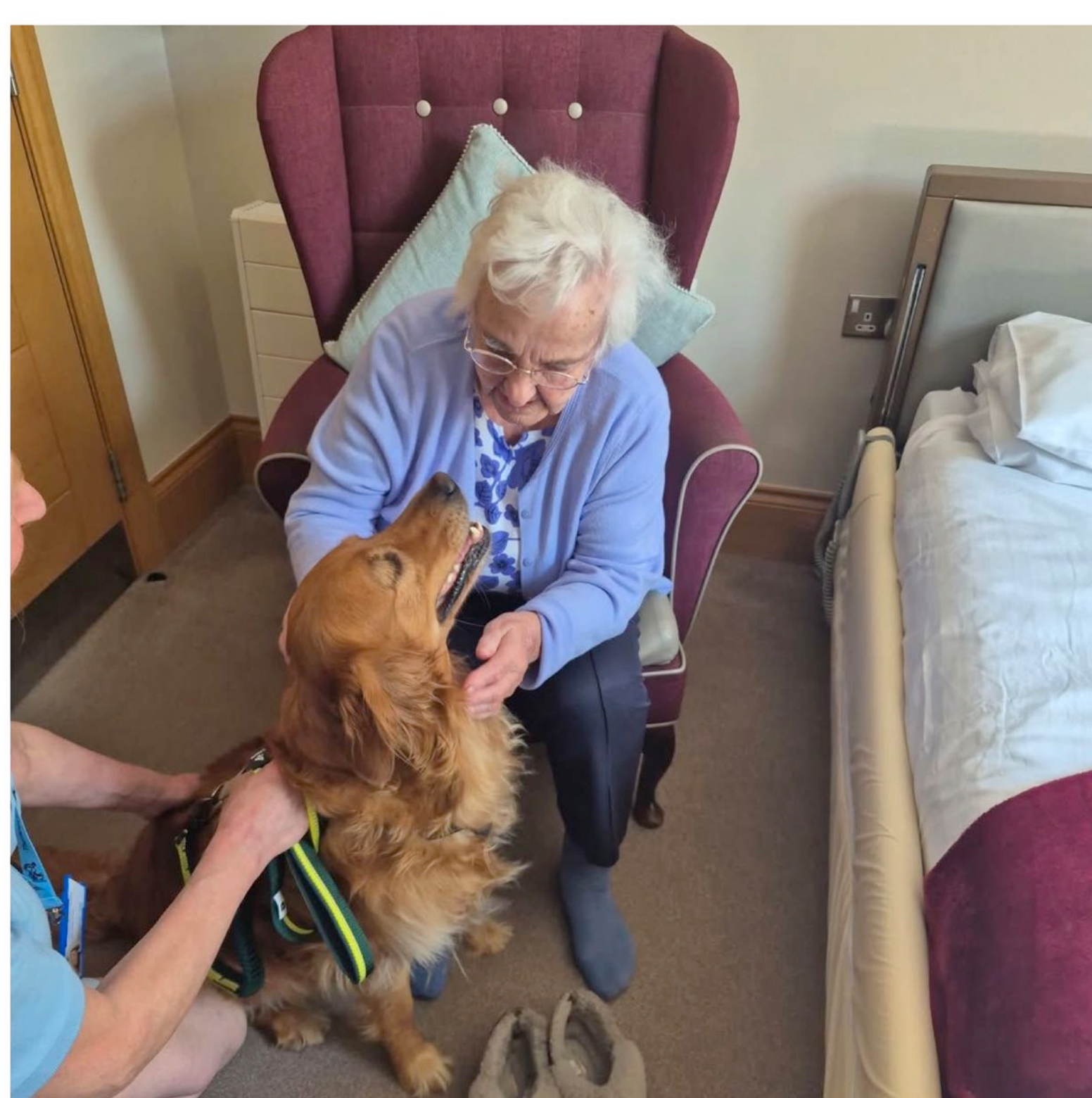
It was a meaningful visit and a chance to listen to personal experiences and reflect together. To our gentlemen who shared their stories, thank you for your service.

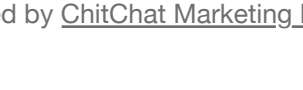
